**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF
HARRISONVILLE, MISSOURI AMENDING SECTION 110.250 OF THE
HARRISONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen wishes to establish Section 110.250 of the Harrisonville Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HARRISONVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 110.250 of the Harrisonville Municipal Code is hereby established to read as follows:

- (A) When a member of the public wishes to participate in a public hearing for an agenda item the following rules will govern their participation:
- (1) Public participation in public hearings shall be limited to those members of the public who have signed up to speak prior to the start of the meeting. A signup sheet shall be provided by City Staff.
 - (2) Those who have signed up to speak shall be allotted three (3) minutes to speak.
 - a. The three (3) minutes shall not be yielded to another person who wishes to speak at the public hearing.
 - b. The person speaking shall forfeit their remaining time should they speak for less than three (3) minutes, but they shall not share their remaining time with another person who wishes to speak and who has met the requirements set forth herein.
 - (3) A member of the public will have one (1) chance to speak. If the person forfeits their opportunity to speak, the same person shall not have the opportunity to speak again at the same public meeting. This shall not prevent the same person from speaking at subsequent public hearings should the person meet the requirements set forth herein.
 - a. If a member of the public forfeits their opportunity to speak at a public meeting, they shall not use their forfeited time in their allotted time to speak at future meetings.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on June 16, 2025.
